
Did you know Narembeen is a Astrotourism Town? Astrotourism is BIG around the world with a growing number of travellers seeking out dark sky experiences.

Hello Autumn!

The March or Autumn equinox marks the transition from summer to autumn in the southern hemisphere. It also marks several astronomical phenomena. The Sun rises directly in the east and sets due west. The Sun will also appear exactly halfway between its northernmost and southernmost location in the sky.

The exact time of the March equinox occurs when the sun is directly above the Earth's equator. This year, this occurs on 20th March at 5.01pm for West Australians. The image below shows how seasons progress as Earth orbits the Sun.
